PORTS OF CALL.... ITINERARY

Day 1 Sun May 20 Depart USA to Barcelona, Spain

Day 2 Mon May 21 Arrive Barcelona. Transfer to our centrally located 4 star First Class Hotel. Remainder of day at leisure to relax or stroll nearby **Las Ramblas**.

Day 3 Tues May 22 Barcelona B
Motor coach to the **Montserrat Mountain Ridge**, 4,050 feet high. This spectacular mountain range is the site of the Monastery where people come to visit the **Black Madonna** who is the patron-virgin of Catalonia. On a natural platform at 2,380 feet above sea level, you will visit the **Benedictine Monastery**, founded in the 11th century. The Benedictine community now numbers 80 monks, and has served the Shrine for almost 1000 years, dedicated to a life of prayer, work and welcoming pilgrims. **Montserrat** is also home to the **Escolans** – the oldest boys' choir in Europe.

Day 4 Wed May 23 Barcelona B
Enjoy an escorted tour of Antoni Gaudi's famous "**Sagrada Familia**" Church, the **Olympic Village** and **Las Ramblas**, the infamous pedestrian way filled with street vendors, pantomime artists, and flower stalls. Stop for a coffee and watch the beautiful people stroll by. Afternoon at leisure to enjoy Barcelona "as you wish."

Day 5 Thur May 24 Barcelona... board ship BLD
Morning at leisure to relax and take in last minute sights and photos of Barcelona. At noon, we will be transferred by motor coach from our hotel to the dock where we will board our 5* luxury Holland America "Nieuw Amsterdam."
Enjoy lunch aboard the ship with time to familiarize ourselves with our *floating hotel*.

Day 6 Fri May 25 Relaxing Day At Sea BLD

Day 7 Sat May 26 Livorno – Florence - Pisa BD
Motorcoach 1 1/2-hour from the ship to **Florence city center**. Visit the **Duomo** (Cathedral), Bronze **Doors of Paradise**, **Santa Croce Church**, resting place of **Michelangelo** and **Galileo**. Upon our return to the ship, stop for photo op of **Pisa's Leaning Tower** and Baptistery (time and traffic permitting).

Day 8 Sun May 27 Civitavecchia - Rome, Italy BD
Motorcoach 1 1/2 hrs to the Eternal City, driving past its most famous highlights: the pyramid of Caius Cestius, Circus Maximus, Palatine Hill, the Coliseum, the Roman Forum, Piazza Venezia, Piazza Barberini, Via Veneto. Enter Vatican City for a visit to **St Peter's Basilica** and **Papal Blessing in St Peter's Square** (Pope's schedule permitting). Pass through Bernini's awesome colonnade and step into this massive basilica that lies at the heart of Roman Catholicism. It houses Michelangelo's **Pietà**, one of the most famous sculptures in the world. Time permitting, visit another **major Basilica, Holy Stairs at St John Lateran** and **Trevi Fountain** before returning to ship.

Day 9 Mon May 28 Naples–Pompeii - Sorrento BD
Nearby is **Pompeii** where meticulous excavation has bared the soul of a city frozen in time since AD 79. **Visit the Ruins of Pompeii**. Before returning to ship, stop in **Sorrento** for lunch "on your own" with time to shop for inlaid wood and **Lemoncello**, a lemon liqueure made from lemons from this area.

Day 10 Tue May 29 Messina, Sicily BLD
Gateway to **Taormina, a beautiful resort town high above the bay**; visit the **Greco-Roman Theater** with time at leisure to *discover as you wish*. Spectacular views of **Mt. Etna**.

Day 11 Wed May 30 Relaxing Day At Sea BLD
Cruising the **Strait of Messina** and the **Ionian Sea** as we make our way to majestic Greece and her islands.

Day 12 Thur May 31 Nafplion, Greece BLD
Today "as you wish" to discover Greece's most prized village. One of the best characteristics of Nafplion is that everything in the Old Town is within walking distance. You will be drawn by the Venetian balconies as you walk through the picturesque alleys of the Old Town. Relax at one of the cafès near the port overlooking the sea. For the more adventurous, discover the Asclepion in Epidaurus, sanctuary of the god of healing or the Grand Palace at Mycenae, once King Agamemnon's domain.

Day 13 Fri June 1 Katakolon, Greece BLD
Gateway to Olympus, site of the original Olympic Stadium and host to some games of the 2004 Olympiad. *We will visit Ancient Olympia & the Village.*

Day 14 Sat June 2 Kerkira, Corfu, Greece BLD
Green and gorgeous is the most luscious of all the Greek islands. Follow winding roads past groves of ancient olive trees; linger in the elegant arcade. The small and ancient side streets are reminiscent of Venice. **Enjoy this magnificent day to discover Corfu "as you wish."**

Day 15 Sun June 3 Dubrovnik, Croatia BLD
The massive city walls of **Dubrovnik** enclose an enchanting World Heritage site: tall medieval houses and marble-paved squares. Visit the majestic **Basilica** in the square & 14th century **Franciscan Monastery** with working pharmacy since 1317. In the Basilica, visit the relics of **St Blaise**.

Day 16 Mon June 4 Venice, Italy BLD
Early afternoon arrival with a visit to St Mark's **Basilica** to experience the marvelous mosaics and divine frescoes. Wonder at the opulence of the **Doges Palace and Rialto Bridge**. Visit the **Murano Glass Showroom** to admire the blown glass works and linger over cappuccino on the Ca d'Oro. Our ship is in port overnight giving you time to enjoy being serenaded after dark on a memorable **Gondola** ride through the **Grand Canal** with your "someone special."

Day 17 Tues June 5 Depart for USA B
