FULL ITINERARY

Day 1 Sat. April 14 Depart USA
Prepare for a spectacular "Journey of a Lifetime!!"

Day 2 Sun April 15 Palermo D
Arrival in the historical city of **Palermo** - the Capitol and largest city in **Sicily**. Palermo's cathedral, "**Santa Maria Assunta**" is the site scholars believe a temple existed in Roman times. Arab records mention the existence of a large temple on this site when they conquered Palermo in 831. Later it became a mosque and was consecrated by Count Roger as a Christian Church. Panorama city tour on route to our hotel. Remainder of day at leisure, dinner at your hotel.

Day 3 April 16 Palermo - Monreale - Cefalu BD
Morning city tour of **Palermo** featuring the **Quattro Canti**, a splendid example of Spanish Baroque architecture, including highlights such as the monumental 16th century **Pretoria Fountain**, **Piazza Bellini** with its 3 churches - St. Caterina 16th century, St. Cataldo 12th century & **Martorana**, a masterpiece of Norman art dating back to 1143. Continue to the famous **Benedictine Abbey of Monreale** (where King William II is portrayed crowned by Christ in a mosaic wall panel). You will be dazzled by the 12 century gem-like mosaics which represent the complete cycle of the old and New Testament. Afternoon, visit Cefalu, small fishing town famous for it's magnificent Romanesque Cathedral. **Welcome Dinner in a local Sicilian Restaurant.**

Day 4 April 17 Marsala- Agrigento BLD
Morning departure along the western coast to Marsala. It was here that Garibaldi landed in 1860, liberating Sicily and eventually the whole peninsula. Visit a local wine estate enjoy lunch & wine tasting in the area of **Marsala**, known for their sweet wine. Proceed to **Agrigento**, a picturesque town built on a hillside facing the sea, for dinner and overnight.

Day 5 April 18 Agrigento - Siracusa BD
Morning visit of the **Valley of the Temples** including the Temple of **Zeus** - the Shrine of the Gods of the Underworld featuring the 5th century BC **Temple of Castor and Pollux**, the **Temples of Hercules and Concord** - the perfectly proportioned and best preserved of all existing Greek temples and the Temple of Hera (Juno) standing alone in splendid solitude. Proceed to **Siracusa**, the ancient capital of the Greek Empire of **Magna Graecia** to visit the most important ancient monuments such as the **Parco Archeologico della Napoli (Roman & Greek Theatre)**, Latomia del Paradiso with the **Ear of Dionysius** - an enormous artificial cave with unusual acoustic properties and other highlights. Dinner at your hotel in Siracusa.

Day 6 April 19 Siracusa - Mt. Etna- Taormina BD
Morning departure to **Taormina**, "*Queen of the Mediterranean*" forming a balcony overlooking the sea at the foothills of **Mt. Etna**. Enjoy a splendid drive up to the mighty Mt. Etna, the largest active Volcano in Europe. Afterwards proceed to magnificent Taormina, where you'll enjoy the rest of the afternoon at leisure to stroll through the village and visit the many shops. Dinner at our splendid hotel.

Day 7 April 20 Taormina / Overnight Ferry BD
Morning **panoramic city tour** via Piazza Vittorio Emanuele on the side of the Roman Forum, and the recently unearthed remains of the Imperial Roman Baths, the Greek Theatre. On to the Piazza IX Aprile to the gate of the Torre dell' Orologio which leads to the medieval part of town. On the **Piazza del Duomo** is the majestic 13 C Norman Cathedral. Afternoon at leisure in Taormina before boarding your *overnight Ferry* from Catania, Sicily to Naples, Italy. Dinner tonight is on board the ferry.

Day 8 April 21 Naples - Pompeii - Sorrento BD
Morning arrival in Naples. Upon arrival, we make our way to the splendid and fascinating city of **Pompeii**, buried in 79 AD under the ashes of erupting **Mt. Vesuvius**. You will be amazed as you walk through the Roman Forum and the Market Place. The narrow streets and luxurious villas of this sumptuous town are literally frozen in time. After lunch (on our own) we continue to the unforgettable resort town of **Sorrento** high above the **Bay of Naples**, passing through hundreds of acres of orange and lemon trees with a view of towering **Mt. Vesuvius**. Dinner at our hotel.

Day 9 Sun April 22 Sorrento <optional Capri > BD
Splendid day at leisure to relax and enjoy the beautiful city of **Sorrento** best known for the magnificent **inlaid wood** furniture. Also from this area are ceramics in deep blues and yellows. Take time to enjoy the quaint shops, taste homemade **Limoncello** liquor made from the fresh lemons grown in this area. *Optional* excursion to the **Isle of Capri** - "Pearl of the Gulf of Naples." This Isle is truly paradise encircled by crystal clear deep blue waters. Perhaps let a hydrofoil whisk you away to the romantic **Blue Grotto** or enjoy a café latte as you watch the "beautiful people" go by. **Dinner in local a restaurant in Sorrento.**

Day 10 April 23 Sorrento - San Giovanni Rotondo BD
Today we continue our journey through the mainland of Italy as we drive across the Appennine Mountains and make our way east to **San Giovanni Rotondo**. Still visited daily by thousands of pilgrims, **Padre Pio** de Pietralcina (1887-1968) lived most of his life here. Famed for his saintliness, he received the "**stigmata**" of Christ on Sept 20, 1918 bleeding daily from his hands and feet for 50 yrs. Dinner and overnight at your hotel.

Day 11 April 24 San Giovanni - Padre Pio - Rome BD
Morning visit of San Giovanni Rotondo, ancient baptistery, S. Maria delle Grazie Church (*housing the incorrupt body of Padre Pio*). Nearby steps lead to the **Via Crucis** (Stations of the Cross) with bronzes by F. Messina. After lunch we make our way towards the "**Eternal City of Rome**." Cradle of Western Civilization and the heart of Catholicism. Relax over dinner at **Le Due Colonne Restaurant** in Rome. Magnifico!!

Day 12 Wed April 25 Rome BD
We begin our day in the **Vatican** by attending a **Papal Audience** in St. Peter's Square (pope's schedule permitting). Immediately following the Papal Audience, we will visit the **Vatican Museum** and **Sistine Chapel**, Michelangelo's masterpiece. Upon exiting, we will enter the magnificent **St. Peter's Basilica** for a guided tour of the largest Basilica in the world. In the afternoon, visit to Basilica of **St. Paul Outside the Walls**. Enjoy a panorama city tour of this magnificent city en route back to our hotel. Tonight, enjoy a relaxing dinner at our hotel.

Day 13 Thurs April 26 Assisi - Rome BD
Relax and enjoy as we cross the breathtaking countryside of the **Umbrian Valley** and enter the peace-filled city of **Assisi**, home of **St. Francis**. Visit the **Basilica** with frescos by Giotto, the **tomb of St. Francis**, the **Church of St. Clare** housing her "*incorrupt*" body and the cross of **San Damiano**. Enjoy lunch (on own) at our favorite deli, *Bodega di Saponi*, and ask Fabrizio to make you the best sandwich on homemade foccaccia bread. Later visit the **Basilica of Santa Maria degli Angeli** housing the **Portiuncula** (the little church St. Francis built), the thorn-less rose bush and the place where he prayed. Return to **Rome** for dinner at our hotel.

Day 14 Friday April 27 Rome BD
Morning sightseeing of **Christian Rome** featuring the **Basilica of St. John Lateran** (Holy Staircase), **St. Peter in Chains** (statue of Moses by Michelangelo), **Santa Maria Maggiore**, and more. Afternoon at leisure for last minute shopping, ancient **Roman Baths**, the **Forum, Colosseum**. Maybe walk along the **Via Veneto**, gather around the **Spanish Steps** for a photo, enjoy a gelato at the **Piazza Navonna**, or sip a cappuccino at a lively café. Remember to toss a coin in the **Trevi Fountain** to guarantee your return to Rome. **Festive Farewell Dinner tonight with wine and music in Rome!!**

Day 15 Sat April 28 Depart for USA B
Morning **departure** to the Rome Airport for our return flight home with fond memories of Bella Italia and our many new friends. **Arrivederci Roma, Ciao Italia!!**
